

ONE-DAY GROUP ITINERARY

Start your day at the Madison County Chamber of Commerce Welcome Center (73 Jefferson Street), where your guests can use the restrooms, shop for souvenirs, and check out *The Bridges of Madison County* movie memorabilia. Then head out on your step-on guided tour of the bridges through the Chamber of Commerce. Add coffee and freshly baked apple fritters for \$3.00/per person.



Your two-hour tour (\$12.00 per person) will include Roseman Covered Bridge, which figured prominently in the movie, and City Park (home to Cutler-Donahoe Covered Bridge, an English hedge maze, whimsical wooden sculptures, and more). Finally you'll visit Holliwell Covered Bridge, the second one used in the film.



Return to the Winterset Historic Courthouse Square for lunch. From sit-down dining to boxed lunches to eating on their own, we have something to fit your group's needs!



Tour the only museum in the world dedicated to Hollywood legend John Wayne. The John Wayne Birthplace & Museum (205 S. John Wayne Drive, Winterset) honors Winterset's own in grand style and features the largest private collection of John Wayne memorabilia in existence. Open daily excluding major holidays from 10 am to 5 pm. www.johnwaynebirthplace.museum.

If arts and crafts are more your pace, a visit to the Iowa Quilt Museum is a must! The museum brings in new, curated exhibits every few months, so there's always something new to see. www.iowaquiltmuseum.org



For the best of Madison County's history, head to the Madison County Historical Complex. Located on 25 picturesque acres, it houses a history museum, a Victorian-era home, and nine authentic historical buildings (including a one-room schoolhouse and train depot) moved to the complex.
