- Artists must remain on site during the event. No exceptions.
- Artists must attend the evening reception 3-6pm
- Artists can promote their artwork (no sales) during the festival and can promote tips via electronic and/or cash collections.
- Artists are expected to finish at least one piece of artwork during the event to frame and sell at the reception.
- Artists are expected to bring their own materials.

Artists will be given a list of approved locations via email Saturday, June 13th.
